CYCLING IN THE TRAMUNTANA

Three routes with top Mallorcan cyclist Joan Horrach

A former pro with ten years' experience under his belt, Joan Horrach is Mallorca's best known professional cyclist. He has taken part in several editions of the Tour de France, Giro d'Italia and Vuelta de España, winning a stage of the 2006 Giro. Born in the village of Deià, he knows the island's roads like the back of his hand!

Joan has designed three cycling trips, all starting out from the hotel, for enthusiasts to get to know the real Mallorca from the saddle of their bike. Each trip is of a different length, ranging from 40 km to 100 km, adapting the pace to suit each group and stopping as many times as necessary.

In all three cases, you will pass through some of the island's most beautiful stretches of countryside, with climbs up to places like the village of Valldemossa or the Coll de Soller, enjoying scenery as different as the mountain villages of the north or the vineyards of Mallorca's plains. To add an extra touch of local flavour, there might be a trip to a winery or a paella at a restaurant with spectacular sea views.

TRAM TO SOLLER

A scenic ride back in time

Enjoy a scenic tram ride from the Port of Soller to the center of Soller, finishing the journey on the main square with its impressive cathedral and numerous restaurants and cafés.

1913 Mallorca's first electric tram line was inaugurated, running between Soller and the Port of Soller. The construction of the Soller tram began after the inauguration of the Palma to Sóller railway line.







CENTENARY TRAIN TO PALMA
